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White Hot Y2K Bordeaux Vintage Has Something for Everyone!

The frenzy of the 2000 Bordeaux campaign has been like no other we have ever experienced. It is record-breaking vintage in many ways. First, in worldwide customer demand. It's been 5 years since a great vintage and there are millions of new wine drinkers in the USA who were just getting exposed to fine wine in 1996. Clyde's battle to acquire the best wines at the best prices and to get them in the hands of our loyal customers was tough. The entire country was calling for weeks on end and the French refused to sell the wines until they had the world whipped into a frenzy.

The pricing also smashes all records—no surprise here. You have to pay top dollar for famous name wines: Ch Latour \$289+, Lafite, Mouton, Margaux, Haut Brion \$279+. But, as the French say to me, "How much do you buy Screaming Eagle for and how long have they been in business?" The fine quality of the wines produced here in California and the competition they present has risen the scale of quality around the world.

Lastly, the quality of the 2000 vintage is record breaking. There has never been a vintage of such high quality in all of the regions of Bordeaux. If you want to start a fine Bordeaux wine collection, now is time. If you want to collect wines under \$50, or even under \$20, you can do it easily and the wines will be superb. Here is a list of top picks and values of the 2000 vintage.

I always collect the second wines of Bordeaux' greatest estates and this is the year to do just that! The difference in overall quality is minimal but the difference in price is astronomical. Don't miss this opportunity. I've bought every one of them for my collection. The other thing I love, aside from the price, is that they drink earlier in their life because they are usually the softer and more forward barrels.

2000 Alter Ego de Palmer. Dark firm wine that exudes all the ripeness and power of 2000 .Ripe blackberry jam type fruit with hints of wood and leather.

2000 Carruades de Lafite. Lafite made a stunning 2000 and is quite possibly the greatest Lafite-Rothschild ever made. Lovely pure fruit with exquisite balance, restrained, super tasting wine with unreal balance. Over \$240 difference between Lafite and Carruades, is the price difference worth it? You tell me. Almost a case of Carruades for one bottle of Lafite.

Although it's not a first growth many people think it should be because Château Léoville-Las-Cases makes three great wines. Las-Cases, of course, at \$139+, and a second wine called Clos du Marquis. This second has the incredible purity of fruit and definition that are hallmark qualities of Las-Cases, along with a succulent texture in the mouth. Killer wine. The third wine is possibly the greatest value of the entire vintage—**Château Potensac, the great Cru Bourgeois, (\$15.99)** can compete with any \$50 California Cabernet. Dark purple and effusive wine, very strong but no hardness, the tannins match the fruit!

2000 Haut-Batailley. Much like the above three great wines are produced on the Borie family properties. Ducru at \$82.95++, Grand Puy Lacoste at 43.95++ and Haut Batailley. For the first time in my tastings Haut Batailley was superior to GPL. Superb entry in the mouth, soft layers of ripe, dark, grapey fruit in absolute harmony. A bit toasty and very long on the finish, a superlative value!! **\$23.99!!**

2000 Prieure-Lichine. The 2000 is a big, soft, rich wine. Velvety, ripe fruit that Clyde calls a "show-girl" which means the wine will be lovely young. **\$25.95**

2000 Haut-Bailly. Haut-Bailly is a perfect example of an estate who made as great a wine as they've ever made and the price is reasonable. Dark, rich and firm, Haut Bailly strikes a fine balance of minerals and earthy fruit along with spicy notes of cloves and violets. Thick, long, and fleshy. **\$35.95!!**

New Wines from Franciscan to Finish off Your Summer!

What a summer in Northern California. Bye, bye, El Niño! A cool April was followed by was one of the warmest Mays on record, a very warm June, and so far in July, the weather is just flat out HOT. If this keeps up it will be an extremely early harvest all over California. What wine am I drinking in this extremely warm weather? The **1999 Franciscan Cuvée Sauvage Chardonnay (\$25.99)**, of course. This deliciously rich Chardonnay is golden in color with a creamy, buttery texture. This wine goes through 100% malolactic fermentation and is fermented in French oak. Franciscan, which owns Estancia, has produced three very interesting reds for 1998; two in contrasting styles while the other seems to be a combination. The **1998 Estancia Alexander Valley Meritage (\$27.99)** is a wonderfully soft and approachable Cabernet-based wine. It is aged in 100% American oak and shows that toasty, flashy style that screams California. Red currant and berry fruit highlight this spicy and soft wine. Perfect for those late summer barbecues! The next red from the Franciscan line-up is the **1998 Franciscan Magnificat (\$36.99)**, which is more French in style. This wine sees 100% French oak and shows much more structure and firmness than the Estancia. More red cherry in its fruit character, with flavors of cedar and minerals, the Magnificat is focused, elegant, yet still full. It drinks well now and also would be a good wine to age for 3-5 years. Almost a combination of the two previous wines, the **1998 Mount Veeder Napa Cabernet Sauvignon (\$36.99)** is 80% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Merlot. It is aged in 50% American and 50% French oak. Deep and concentrated with flavors of red and black licorice, spicy cassis-like fruit, it finishes with firm but ripe tannins. This wine tastes more like a 1997 Cabernet with its richness and intensity of fruit. Great Cabernet Sauvignon, but unfortunately limited. Call for availability.

2000 Shenandoah Amador County Sauvignon Blanc (\$8.99) We've all been drinking lots of Sauvignon Blanc lately, finding them refreshing and lively. Just the thing for a summer's evening. This wine is very floral both on the nose and palate. Kind of reminded me of getting off the plane in Hawaii. We're talking floral here! For those of you who prefer a little more fruit to your finish, this is your baby.

1999 Dreyer Sonoma California Chardonnay (\$8.99) Surprisingly rich at this price. You have a well-made wine with oodles of fruit and a little bit of oak on the edge. A definite step up from the mass-produced wines in its price range. It has a long finish, not overripe and soft, one of the best under \$10.

1998 Duncan Peak Mendocino Cabernet Sauvignon (\$29.99) This wine has been a favorite since our first vintage 1995. These people get very small yields per acre, stomp around on the grapes, then bottle up the juice. It's perfect! Duncan Peak is smooth and very elegant; you will be impressed. My lovely wife Sherry was so taken by the wine she stayed up to watch all of *Cast Away* with me, so I wouldn't have to drink this beautiful wine alone. Isn't that sweet?

Beware the Vintage Hype

With all the exposure highly rated vintages get these days, it's very easy to overlook some great wines and very good vintages by focusing on the unobtainable high-point darlings of the magazines. We've all had magnificent experiences with wines from overlooked vintages, usually because of luck, but it does not have to be that way. Watch for those winemakers devoted to their land and wine, and just taste what can be done with the "other" vintages. One illustration is the Pine Ridge wines from the 1998 vintage. Classic, stylish and complex, these wines are ageable, available and fabulous. Gary and Nancy Andrus take great pride in the meticulous care they take with every aspect of winemaking, from site selection to distribution. This is why they can make a great wine in a difficult vintage. The **1998 Pine Ridge Rutherford Cabernet** is a great example of what makes Rutherford unique. This wine (the 20th vintage) is the original wine of Pine Ridge. Dark fruits and minerals on the nose, soft ripe tannins and a silky "Rutherford dust" feel on the palate, mingling with spicy oak and a sweet, smooth, cherry finish, this wine will age gracefully for 5+ years. The **1998 Pine Ridge SLD Cab** is another example from one of our favorite appellations. Spicy, sexy, wild berry fruit, and a smooth integration of oak combine to make a very impressive wine. The **1998 Pine Ridge Howell Mountain** follows suit with the ripe, chunky mountain fruit (typical of Howell Mountain), cassis liqueur, and hefty brooding solidity, spicy notes abounding and seamlessly integrated toasty oak lead onto a long luscious finish. It was bottled unfiltered and unfiltered and will really reward cellaring. Another great example is the **1998 Caymus Napa Cabernet**. For anyone interested in ratings, this wine was rated the same in the biggest wine mag, yet gets far less attention than its 1997 ancestor, in fact the range of ratings in the last 9 years for this wine is only 6 points. The 1998 shows cherry syrup and spicy cedar on the nose, and follows through with a succulent mouthful of sweet, black-cherry fruit, minerals, cedar box, and spice, and a long, cherry finish. The ripeness of fruit and softness of tannins combine in a wine drinkable now and for 6+ years. And don't miss the ripe and unctuous **1999 Pine Ridge Dijon Clones Chard** with its beautiful pineapple fruit and spicy oak filling the palate.

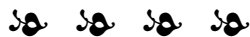

An Interview with James T Barr, Winemaker Extraordinaire

It is very rare indeed to be granted an audience with the master himself, James T Barr (the T doesn't stand for anything, it's just there to hold him up), winemaker for Lazy Goat Vineyards. This free-wheeling one-sided discussion ranges from his early days as a Mouton Cadet to his arrival as one of the most, um, idiosyncratic winemakers of our generation. Thankfully, Barr was relaxed enough to let his red-tinted hair down and really let fly with his thoughts and feelings about wine the world over. The interview is presented here, unedited and unbelievable.

JZ: Jim, thanks for sitting down with me. I know you'd rather stand, and I appreciate it. How did you get started in the wine business?

JB: I was, first and foremost, born. I couldn't have gone on without that. My interest really began in my early teens, when I was a Mouton Cadet (apprentice sheep) for Gallows winery. I mopped the brows of the pickers and picked the brows of the moppers. Those were hard times indeed.

JZ: Is that how you came up with the Lazy Goat name? A takeoff on apprentice sheep, I'll wager.

JB: Yes, I've always been into goats and sheep.

JZ: What was your first wine experience?

JB: I believe it was the **1985 Ducru Beaucaillou (\$109.00)**, a fabulous St-Julien. No one knew at the time that Robert Parker would score it 92 of 100 points. But you could tell that it was special—the balance between the precociously rich cherry fruit and stately structure was flawless. It is definitely Ducru, but possesses the supple qualities of an '85.

JZ: What, in your opinion, are the most important factors in making a great wine? Grapes, terroir, weather?

JB: Well, grapes don't have much to do with it. In fact, they are the least important. Now dirt, that's a big one. Sun . . . I don't know. I could never really understand bright stuff. Bottles are important. Otherwise you'd have wine in cans and couldn't charge a @\$%^&* arm and a leg for the stuff.

JZ: Hmmm, yes. Tell me about some other Bordeaux wines you've enjoyed.

JB: I've always been a fan of the Red Sox. And of **1990 Bordeaux. Calon Ségur (\$79.95)** and **Léoville-Las-Cases (\$209.00)** certainly come to mind. Fenway Park too. Do you think Sox owner Tom Yawkey's name was Yorkey, but the accent changed the spelling? Everone knows Las-Cases, and the 1990 is arguably one of the greatest ever. A huge wine, super concentrated and super complex. Quite ripe for Las-Cases, but that is the vintage talking. Calon-Ségur is another one—much more subtle, Bordeaux-like, if you will. And ready to drink. Lovely! The 2000 vintage is getting the hype, and the wines are A+ but, for goodness sakes, look at the value of these wines in comparison! We'll come back to our senses eventually.

JZ: That last excerpt was very well stated.

JB: Well, I just read what you handed me. I don't care much about the smell and taste stuff. The dirt is the thing, like I told you.

JZ: That's more like it. What is new at Lazy Goat Vineyards?

JB: We experimented with a sparkling wine grape, but they all blew up during the last heat wave. The chicken grapes are ready to be picked, they're really amazing. They still taste a bit like pork, but we're really close. We are making a dessert wine modeled after the great **1990 Guiraud (Inquire)**. I just love a wine that has explosive tropical fruit and extract, but also the acid to balance it. Guiraud is like that. Our wine will be made of Alicante from our vineyards in Sherman Oaks. I was going to call it Gee-Roh. We just changed it to Al Sherman to reflect the grape and the area. But it doesn't mean anything.

JZ: No, I guess those aren't the important things.

JB: No, it's like I told you. It's the dirt. It's all in the dirt. And the bottles. I don't like cans. But the dirt's the thing. —Joe Zugelder

Jim's August Gems

As I write this, it is 9 pm the day before celebration of the birth of our nation and nearly 100°. I have several heavy-duty "cats" at our vineyard in Anderson Valley, digging out some incredibly large old-growth redwood stumps and contouring the site to allow proper drainage in what will be a 5-acre block of a Pommard-clone Pinot Noir next spring.

This year's vintage began with a very warm summer that promises an early, plentiful, and super-high quality harvest. We expect our first ripe crop to arrive at the end of August/early September, depending on the weather conditions the rest of this season. Based on flowering and cluster-set, this vintage has begun in near-purrfect conditions.

It amazes me that the 2000 Bordeaux vintage has created such a shark feeding frenzy. The question to ask is, "Just how much higher can these future prices go?" Consider that you have available for current consumption wonderful Bordeaux from exceptional vintages at less than half the price of the 2000s. A perfect example of this is **1998 Château Belgrave, Haut-Médoc (\$18.95)**. This fifth-growth Bordeaux has been producing outstanding wines since 1985 under the new ownership of the Dourthe Company. Deep ruby in color, the aromatics and palate impressions explode with cassis-like to blackcurrant fruit that is underscored by roasted, cedary components. The tannins are soft and buried in lush, well-structured, ripe fruit that makes this a very drinkable wine now, but with the possibility of aging another five to ten years. (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

The new vintages from my favorite Loire Valley producer, **Franc Millet**, have just arrived and they are absolutely stunning wines. The **2000 Sancerre Blanc (\$10.99)** is gorgeous Sauvignon Blanc, showing a bright grapefruit to melon-like fruit quality, excellent lushness on the palate, and a clean, mouthwatering, crisp finish. Millet's **1999 Sancerre Rouge 1999 (\$12.95)** is produced from estate grown Pinot Noir and will conjure up thoughts of a beautifully crafted Côtes de Beaune. Medium-deep ruby in color, the nose is classic Pinot of a meaty, almost bacon-like tone interwoven with dried rose petals. In the mouth, you will be treated to a wine of incredible balance and structure, soft yet lush Pinot fruit flavors, and a long, warm finish. Both of these lovely creatures are exceptional buys and shouldn't be missed. (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

Last June 2000, Greg made a pilgrimage-buying trip to Austria and brought back with him some fabulous wines at dirt-cheap prices. There is one that I have fallen totally in love with, the **1999 Gruner Veltiner, "Alte Reben," Johann Topf (\$13.99)**. Johann Topf has produced an outstandingly wonderful single-vineyard, dry white that is extraordinarily complex with flavors and aromatics of tropical to pineapple-like fruit with just a hint of pine nuts, excellent acid structure, and a fresh, clean finish. (🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷🍷)

Their **1990 vintage (\$38.99)** has a pretty golden color, a nutty but still fresh nose and hints of marmalade and racy quince on the palate. A very showy vintage Champagne priced very fairly. Also new in stock is the **1996 Gati-nois (\$46.99)** which comes from the famous grand cru of Ay, in the valley of the Marne, the heart of the Champagne region. This wine is made all from estate owned vineyards. It has gorgeous deep golden color, tons of Pinot character on the nose, red fruit, and hazelnuts. In the mouth it is very rich and broad, a big masculine style that still has fineness and subtlety on the finish. A great way to check out the seriousness of the 1996 vintage. For dessert, I would like to recommend the **Antonio Barbadillo Laura Moscatel (\$22.99)**. This wine is made out of Muscat, the famous dessert grape of antiquity. It's a fresh, grapey, sweet, ripe wine with a mellow, but lively finish. A must try for any dessert wine aficionado! Made from stocks that average 40 years old, it is an incredible value! And that is just what you’ll find in this vineyard. Along with a stony, mineral note there is a core of ripe Fuji apple, honey and spice nuances. Very fine balancing acidity, deft handling of their use of new barrels, and a lingering finish.

1999 Saint Aubin “Montceau” M Colin (\$29.99)

1999 Saint-Aubin “Les Combes” M Colin (\$29.99) As Clive Coates says, Saint-Aubin may be too rich in premiers crus! These wines offer tremendous value from this unsung-hero of appellations. Marc Colin makes superb wines, that have balance, purity and definition. The “Montceau” is rich with ripe citrus-apple fruit framed by light vanilla notes. Round and full on the palate, this is the more “Californian” of the two. The “Les Combes” shows more earth, smoke, ripe citrus, and a chalky texture. Racy and with fine length, this is the value that will reward a little cellar time.

1999 Puligny-Montrachet “Folatières” Paul Pernot \$59.95 What a beauty this is! I confess, this is a favorite vineyard in Puligny (I have a few) but this wine sings. Smokey with minerals, ripe citrus, pear, and a hint of earth, the wine has gained more middle fat since first tasting. The wine is quite rich and concentrated with superb balance and length.

Pour Votre Plaisir

More of the exciting 1999 Burgundies are arriving. As Clive Coates said to me the other day, "The combination of perfectly ripe phenolics, perfectly ripe tannins, and perfectly ripe fruit that the 1999s exhibit is extremely rare." These wines show their terroirs beautifully, as graceful in youth as they will be with age.

Last Spring I tasted at **Maison Champy**, the oldest negociant in Burgundy, founded in 1720. In 1990 Henri and Pierre Meurgey acquired Champy and began a rebuilding process, with a dedication to producing the finest Burgundies, letting the vineyards speak, not the winemaking. In the last two years, they added a new enologue (winemaker), Dimitri Bazas. He has transformed their wines, which were already sound, into an elegant and lovely collection, each true to its terroir and a great value as well.

The **St Aubin, "Murgers Dents de Chien," 1er Cru (\$19.99)** shows a nose of toasty oak, slate, and minerals. On the palate, it has nice richness, great length, and finishes with spiciness, balance and minerality. The **Puligny Montrachet (\$29.95)**, entirely from the **Enceigneres vineyard**, next to Bâtard and Bienvenue Bâtard, has excellent structure, with focused fruit, a toasty nose, and a very long palate impression. This is a bargain.

1999 was a great success in the Côte de Beaune. A real steal is the **Santenay, "Clos Genet" (\$15.99)** from the next village south of Chassagne Montrachet, with a bright garnet/ruby color, prominent cherry notes on the nose, flavors of cherries and wild strawberries, and an elegant structure with lots of charm. The **Beaune, "Champs-Pimont," 1er Cru (\$24.99)** is on Clive Coate's hit list of the best red wines of the vintage. It is Domain bottled, and is balanced, well-made wine, with a purple hue, deep color and ripe, soft black fruit. The **Volnay, "Fremiets," 1er Cru (\$27.95)** combines almost California richness with classic Volnay aromas and flavors. Do Not Miss This Wine! The **Volnay, "Les Cailleret," 1er Cru (\$29.95)** is Volnay of real silk, lace and the complexity of all the little red fruits you can imagine.

From the Côte de Nuit, we have the **Vosne Romanée, "Les Beaux-Monts," 1er Cru (\$39.95)** with rich fruit, coffee and cocoa notes, very good acidity, fine tannins, pretty, rich, round fruit and balance. The **Clos Vougeot, Grand Cru (\$49.99)** has licorice, spice, pepper, smoke and meaty aromas. Deep, dark and concentrated, with black fruits, it has a very young and muscular style. Finally, there is one wine from 1998 we could not resist. The **1998 Vosne Romanée, "Les Suchots," 1er Cru (\$39.95)** has such bright racy fruit notes, focus, acidity and structure that we had to get some more.

Here in Kamptal Gruner Veltliner, Austria's most widely planted grape variety produces some of Austria's most exciting wines. The **1999 Johann Topf Gruner Veltliner "Wechselberg" (\$11.99)** is an outstanding wine. It has the classic Gruner nose of white pepper, lentil and grapefruit rind coupled with a richly textured body and centered with a great core of concentrated fruit. Dry, clean and vibrantly refreshing this wine's great concentration and balance make it a perfect aperitif or excellent meal accompaniment. For those of you who used to like California Chardonnay but now find it to be merely an alcoholic Oak tea, try

the **1999 Johann Topf Gruner Veltliner "Alte Reben" (\$13.99)**. Topf's "Alte Reben" (Old Vine) is an oak-aged Gruner that has all of the tasty, toasty oak flavor Chardonnay drinkers love coupled with Gruner's great flavor concentration and acidity. A perfect cocktail wine, the "Alte Reben" is so well balanced for a big wine that it actually works very well for robust fish, hearty fowl, or veal dishes as well! For the purists, the **1999 Johann Topf Riesling "Heligenstein" (\$18.99)** is stunning, the wine is bursting with Riesling aromatics that lead to a dry, focused core of richness with extraordinary length. A wine with great aging potential, it's so good now you will be hard pressed to wait 10 years for its glory! If you don't want to wait at all and are into immediate satisfaction there isn't anything more immediately satisfying than Kamptal Zweigelt. The **2000 Johann Topf Zweigelt (Red Wine) (\$9.99)** is exploding with soft, strawberry fruit together with loads of spice blended into the luscious, round, easy drinking body, which has a great finish. A perfect warm weather red, richness enough to fill the mouth but easy to drink with low tannins, a real staff favorite! If you'd like to learn more about the Topf Winery and practice your German, you can go to www.weingut-topf.at for pictures of the vineyards, Johann and Magdalena, and their label gallery. Every year since 1991, when Johann took over for his father, they choose a special work of art to label their vineyard-designated wines. Give them a try you won't be disappointed! —Greg St Clair
